Specific presentation special provision technical subject matter included: Hot Mix Asphalt, Asphalt Treated Base, Permeable Asphalt Treated Base, Porous Hot Mix and Warm Mix Asphalt, and Pervious Cement Concrete specifications.

Future Activities/Plans/Needs:

For the upcoming year, the committee has identified a number of items it plans on addressing including: approval of magnetic density gauges for local agency compaction testing, development of special provisions for reduced driveway construction acceptance testing, development of FHWA approved full depth reclamation and cement treated base special provisions, assist WSDOT with the development of standard electric vehicle charging facility specifications, and outreach with WSDOT for a standardized recycled material documentation methodology for local agencies.
