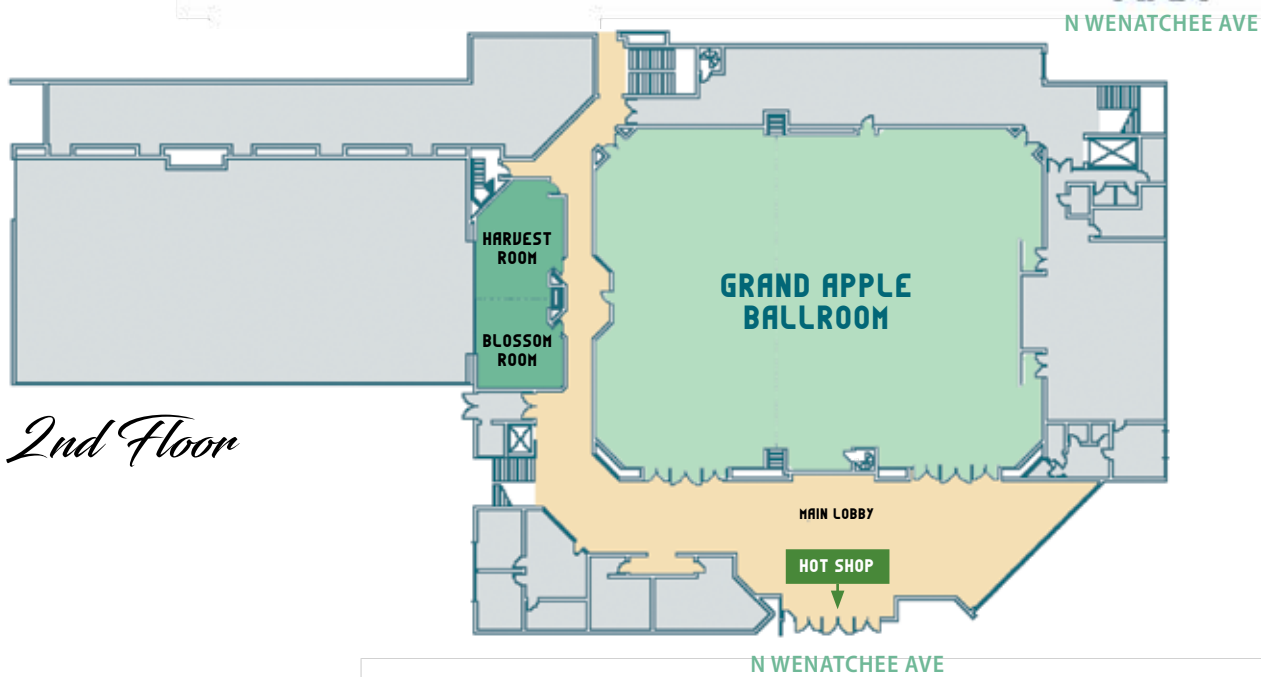
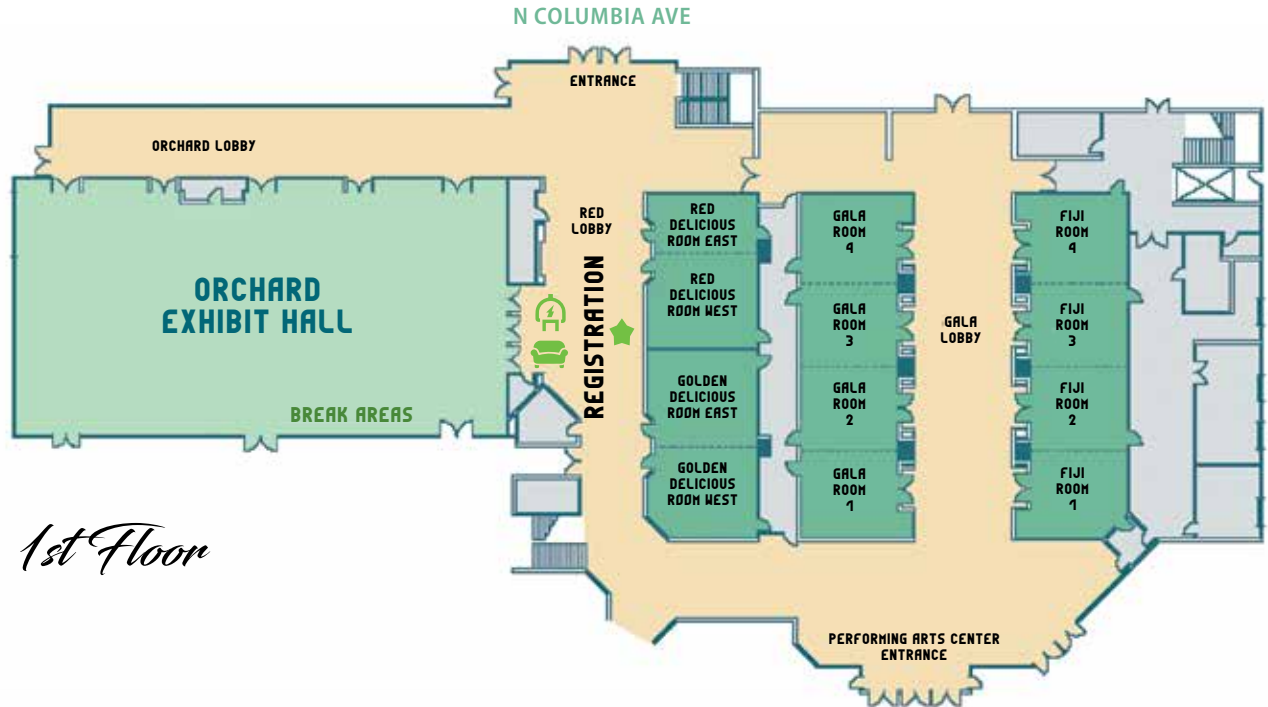

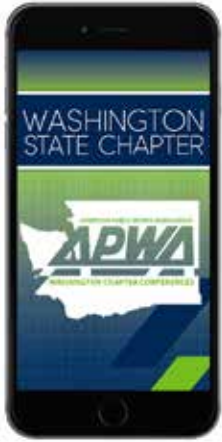

Wednesday at lunch, we will be conducting a "Pass the Hat" fundraiser to support Alatheia's therapeutic and adaptive riding programs. **Riding physically strengthens the body in a way that can actually help our special needs riders learn how to walk.**

Ranging in age from 2 ½ to 86 our riders may have a learning disability, genetic disorder, traumatic brain injury, cerebral palsy, stroke, autism, or epilepsy. The Benefits of Therapeutic Activities on and off the horse help to develop core strength, balance, coordination, social skills and cognitive abilities. The four-directional movement of a horse's walk provides an engagement of the pelvis that more closely resembles walking than some children will ever experience.
